**MEMORANDUM**

On the recommendations of the Selection Committee, Medical Director, GIPMER is pleased to offer a tenure post of Senior Resident to **Dr. \_\_\_\_\_** in the \_\_\_\_\_ Department of this institute on adhoc basis initially upto 89 days or as per further instructions of H&FW Department of GNCTD or till regular incumbents join against the said post in the Pay Scale Rs. 67700/- and other usual allowances admissible, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The appointment is temporary and on a tenure basis as per rules of the residency scheme.
2. His/her present tenure of appointment will be for a period of 89 days extendable or till a regular incumbents joins whichever is earlier, for maximum period of 3 years subject of satisfactory performance certificate after each completed tenure from the Head of the Department concerned. The period of service rendered by his/her as Senior Resident prior to this appointment if any will be counted for reckoning tenure of 3 years as Senior Resident.
3. The Private Practice of any kind what so ever is strictly prohibited. Besides, the candidate will not work simultaneously as Senior Resident in any hospital. Breach of this condition will result in termination of appointment.
4. She/He will wear White Coat with Name Badge at his/her coat. He/She will not smoke in the institute campus while on duty or examining the patients.
5. The appointment may be terminated at any time by giving one month notice by the either side viz the appointee or the appointing authority without assigning any reason. The appointing authority reserve the right of terminating the services of the appointee forth with or before the stipulated period of notice by making payment to him/her of a some equalent some pay and allowances or the unexpired portion thereof.
6. The appointment carries with the liability to serve in any office/department/institutions of GNCT of Delhi and his services are transferable to any office/department/institutions she/He will be liable to serve under the Defence Organization in the time of Emergency.
7. Other condition of service will be governed by the relevant rules and orders in force from time to time.
8. The appointment is provisional and is further subject to:
  - a) Production of Medical fitness from Medical Board, GIPMER, New Delhi.
  - b) Submission of DMC Certificate (with PG qualification) at the time of joining.
  - c) She/He is further directed to bring all the certificate/testimonials (in originals) along with self attested copy of each, at the time of joining to the post.
  - d) Verification of Character and Antecedents by the concerned District Magistrate.
  - e) Declaration regarding his/her not having contracted bigamous marriage.
  - f) She/He will not be entitled to any traveling allowance for joining the institute.
  - g) Production of SC/ST/OBC Certificate (OBC certificate should be issued by the Competent Authority of G.N.C.T of Delhi). In case, the verification reveals the claim to belong to SC/ST/OBC is false at any time, the services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any reason and without prejudice to such action as may be taken under the provision IPC for false production of certificate.
  - h) Other conditions of service will be governed by Residency Scheme.
  - i) Taking oath of allegiance/faithfulness to the constitution of India or making a solemn an affirmation to the affect in the prescribed format.
9. In case of resignation/discontinuation of services 10 days advance notice is required otherwise he/she will have to deposit 10 days salary in lieu of 10 days notice period.

10. Duties:-

- a) The Senior Residents will be directly responsible for supervision of patient care in his/her unit with the assistance of Junior Residents, specially the emergency cases.
- b) She/He will be contacted by the Junior Resident on duty in case of emergency. If she thinks necessary, he/she should consult the physician/surgeon in-charge of the unit or specialist when available.
- c) She/He will go through all the case notes written by Junior Resident and will make corrections where necessary.
- d) Besides taking rounds in the wards during day time, she/he will daily take round late in the evening, with the Junior Resident on call.
- e) On admission days, she/he will attend to cases referred for medical opinion from other wards. If necessary, she/he may contact the physician/surgeon in-charge for necessary advice
- f) In case of death, it is her/his responsibility to scrutinize that case documentation is complete in every respect and will write a brief summary of the case, before it is sent to the Medical Records Section.
- g) She/He will maintain a register to indicate that the relatives of seriously ill patients have been informed through the central registration office of the hospital. This is applicable in case of patients absconding from the ward and also in case of death.
- h) She/He will maintain a book to indicate the patients in his/her charge who would need attention after the night rounds and she/he will apprise the junior resident of such cases.
- i) She/He will oversee the general upkeep and sanitation of the wards earmarked to his/her with the help of nursing staff.
- j) Senior Residents will certify death.
- k) They will conduct teaching session for undergraduate, postgraduate and Junior Residents. They will assist the HOD/HOU in research work.
- l) When Junior Residents are not available, she/he will carry all the duties of a Junior Resident & any other duty assigned by HOD.
- m) While practicing, the appointee doctor is required to prescribe the drugs from EDL in generic form only in the legible handwriting with stamp. Any violation shall attract termination of services with immediate effect.

If any declaration given or information furnished by said doctor proves to be false or if he/she is found to have willfully suppressed any material information, he/she will be liable to be removed from service and any such other action as Government may deem fit.

If the terms & conditions mentioned above are acceptable to him/her, he/she will report to the undersigned within **05** working days from the date of issue of this letter and furnish in writing explicitly that all terms and conditions of appointment are acceptable to him/her. If no reply is furnished within the prescribed time limit, the offer of appointment will be treated as cancelled without any further correspondence.
